That Thing You Do.: Thinking all the way back to 1919, DeMolay has a very serious purpose in view. What do we do and why do we do it that way?

Using State Officers to Help Your Chapter: A panel discussion with our Region's Jurisdictional Officers. How can they help us? How can we help them?

Social Media and DeMolay: The most up-to-date research shows that people of DeMolay age don't use email or voice-to-voice telephone communication much, if at all. So what **DO** they use and how can we, as advisors, join in?

Jurisdictional Officers get together to share ideas and swap methods. Successful jurisdictional programs are often based on the good practices of others. It's time to learn from one another.

Advisors can be the critical factor in a successful chapter. Once we have addressed our membership needs, we are faced with finding, using, and keeping new advisors. We'll look at three major sources of new advisors, getting our prospective adult workers to sign on the dotted line, training them beyond the basic D.A.D. program, and keeping them happy and engaged.

The Executive Officers meet with the regional education staff to continue developing the plans to better train and teach our members and advisors through JO education, LTC, and advanced advisor training.

- D.A.D. training program options

Scenarios: We will take a hard look at a number of potential issues that can bog down a Chapter. Individual tables will come up with their solutions, then the whole group will discuss the problem and share differing ideas.

Where Do We Go From Here? Home is obviously the first answer, but if DeMolay is to grow, we must have a plan of action. What is it? What should we be doing in Kansas City, in the individual jurisdictions, and in the individual chapters?
